You have a right to complain about our service. It's ok to complain.

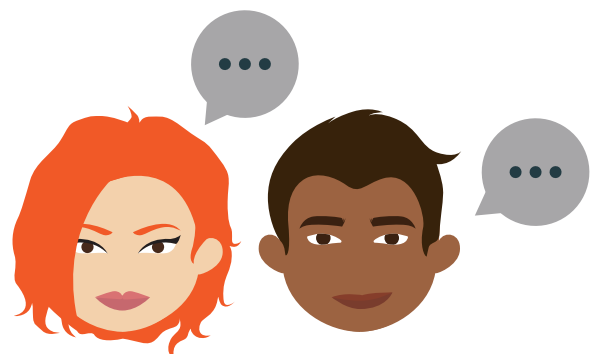
When things go wrong, we can learn from our mistakes and make the service better;
